

# Twister Sight Words

## PREPARATION

Use the chalk to draw a twister board on your driveway or patio. (If you don't have a flat concrete surface, try a nearby park!) Make circles big enough to write one sight word in each, but keep in mind the kids need to be able to reach the words. Repeat some or all of the words so that your little one can choose which word to step on.

## PLAY

**#1** If these sight words are brand new, show the word and have your

kid put a foot or hand on that word. Then show the next word and have them put another hand or foot. Continue until you've used all of the sight words, then start over.

**#2** Once your little one has had some practice say the word out loud, but don't show it. Have your kid find the word on their own.

**#3** Have your child read the cards to you while you find the words on the Twister board.

Please use the chalk only for making the board so it will last for many parents to use.
